What have we been learning?

We have had a super learning week in Jet Class, we have loved creating our ICT jungle book comic strips using the learn pads. We have created our own pictures using paint tools through 'workspace'. They look amazing.



In English we have been applying our knowledge of question openers and question marks to embed our understanding of different punctuation. We used this knowledge to write curious questions about elephants.

In PSHE we have been following the Jigsaw unit focusing on returning to school following lockdown. Jigsaw Jo has been helping us talk about how we can help each other stay safe and happy in school and the rules and routines.

In art we experimented with different printing techniques including rubbing and string printing to create different textures and patterns. We have practiced drawing our chosen jungle animals ready for our silhouettes. We looked closely at the lines, shape and size of our animal.

In English we will be starting our next mini outcome 'What happens next?' We will be creating story boards for our own adventure story based on 'The jungle book'.

In maths we be developing our understanding of counting in 2's. 3's. 5's and 10's.

We will continue to experiment with different print techniques including stamping and rolling.
