What Have We Been Learning?

We have enjoyed rehearsing for our Christmas performance of Hey Ewe this week in Jet Class. The children are becoming more confident with their lines and we are now starting about putting some actions into the performance. Please keep practising your child's lines with them over the next week ready for our performance to you all!

In English this week we have been writing character descriptions of Old Farmer Clegg. The children have been looking for clues in the text and illustrations to imagine what he might be like as a character. They have been using the conjunctions 'so' and 'because' to give more information about him.



In Maths we have been focusing on using a written method to subtract a 2 digit number from a 2 digit number. The children were encouraged to use their existing knowledge of 10's and 1's to help them partition the number that need subtracting. We were very impressed with how well they did this.

In Geography this week we have been looking at maps of our local area to find out what Wickwar's nearest villages, towns and cities are. The children enjoyed having some time to explore the maps and got excited when they found the places they live!







Next Week

In English we will start to learn the oral retelling of Farmer Clegg's Night Out. This will help the children to go on to write an innovated version of the story.

In Maths we are focusing our learning on money. We will use our recent knowledge of addition and subtraction to combine coins to make a given amount and to find change.
