



## Jet Class Newsletter

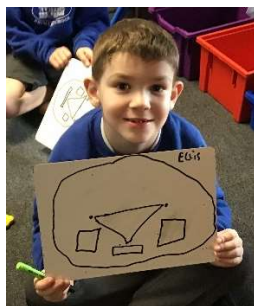
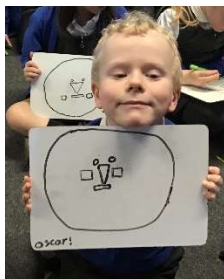
