What have we been learning?

This week in Jet class we have started to plan our next mini outcome 'Will the magic make it come alive?' The children have been creating their own story map for their animation based on the story of 'Hansel and Gretel'. They have created simple backdrops and character puppets with moving parts.

In art the children have been combining their printing and pattern skills to create a natural repeated pattern. The children collected their own natural materials from the woods and used these to paint prints of trees for our animation backdrops. We used rollers, stamps and print blocks.
