What have we been learning?

This week, we have been building upon our subtraction skills to subtract a single digit number from a two digit number. We used numicom, number lines and other methods to subtract. We have also been solving missing number subtraction methods.







We have started our last mini outcomes 'Who's in the news?', we have looked at a range of different questioning words- who, what, where, when, why, how and which. We used these to write interview questions to ask the children from the story 'The Snail and the Whale'.

In Geography we compared Wickwar and Bamburgh (where Grace Darling lived) to see which similarities and differences there were by looking closely at the human and physical features.

In maths we will be looking at both 2D and 3D shapes and will be investigating how many sides, corners, edges etc. We will also be able to name them all confidently.
