What have we been learning?

This week in maths we have been developing our 'more than' skills. We have been solving problems finding the number that is 1, 2, 3 or 4 more than a given number.

In English, we have been using adjectives to describe The Singing mermaid. We used our adjectives to help the sea animals find the mermaid after Sam Sly took her away.

In art, we have started to create our mermaid collage pictures. We have used tissue paper to create the background. We overlapped the tissue paper using different shades of blue to create the sea. We then started sketching our mermaids and mermen looking closely at the lines, shapes and patterns.



We have started our 'Snail and a whale' dance, this week we looked at making small shapes and movement for the snail and large shapes and movements for the whale.
