What Have We Been Learning?

The children have been extremely busy this week and have been wowing us with their hard work.

In English this week we have been writing a setting description of the Place Between. The children have been impressing us with their use of noun phrases to describe and have made some fantastic vocabulary choices.

In Maths we have been building on our addition skills to now add two 2 digit numbers that cross the tens boundary. We have been applying our knowledge of tens and ones and place value to help us answer addition number sentences.

In Science we have started to think about different habitats animals live in and why they are best suited to that habitat. To get the children engaged and curious we posed the question:

"What if ALL animals lived on the grasslands of the Savannah?'

The children were asked to consider the question and use their knowledge of what all living things need to survive to help them think of fors and againsts this idea.
