What have we been learning?

This week we have immersed ourselves in our new class text 'The snail and the whale'. We wrote postcards from the snail telling his friends all about his adventures. We have been focusing on adjectives ending in –er and –est in grammar and confidently applied these new adjectives in our postcard writing to describe what we could see, hear, feel and smell.

In maths we have been developing our addition skills to 20 using number lines and the bar model method.

In geography we explored the geographical vocabulary for human and physical features for a setting. We then labelled an aerial view photograph of Bamburgh (Grace Darlings birthplace) using these features.

In art we have started to paint the sea backgrounds for our Van Gogh seascape paintings. We used brusho, watercolour, acrylic and added salt to create texture to the waves.
