What have we been learning?

The children may have come home this week talking about reading quizzes. In class we have been practicing comprehension quizzes to assess how the children are applying their reading and comprehension skills. The children have all tried really hard as some of the reading is a little challenging. Please can you continue to read with your child five or more times a week as this really does impact on their fluency and understanding.

In English the children have been developing their grammar skills focusing on using the correct tense.

In writing the children have started to plan their own innovated version of 'Leon and the Place Between', they have created their own story mountains thinking about the setting and characters in their version of the story.

In Maths the children have been amazing at subtracting 2 digit numbers to 100, they have been crossing the 10s boundary using a tens and ones table and applying this method to solve bar model calculations.

In art the children have created their own flower polyblock for printing, they designed their own flower outline and then used a blunt pencil to engrave their design into the styrofoam. They used printing ink and a printing roller to create their flower print, demonstrating a good understanding of positive and negative spaces in print.



Next Week

In English we will be starting to write our own innovated narratives of 'Leon and the Place Between' using our planning sheets from this week.

In Maths we are developing our understanding of fractions of shapes and amounts. We will be using $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{3}{4}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{2}{4}$.

In Art we will be designing our own magical polyblock ready to print our magician's cape.
