





Jet Class Newsletter 02.10.2020

What have we been learning?

It has been another really busy week in Jet, but we have had lots of fun and done some amazing learning.

In Music, we came to the end of our unit on tempo and rhythm. We finished this unit by creating our own music scores using 2 notes. We worked in pairs to create a piece of music called 'Elephant Stomp'. The children used their music scores to then perform to the rest of the class.





In Computing we finished our comic strips by using Microsoft Word to add captions. We used our computing skills to change the font, size and colour of our writing.

In English we have created some amazing storyboards to support us with our upcoming writing for our mini outcome "What happens next?". The children have created their storyboard imagining that they would meet one more animal in the jungle- who would it be? What problem would happen between Mowgli and that animal and how would it be resolved? The children then shared their storyboard with the class through a speaking and listening activity.









In Maths we have been working on our counting in 2s,3s,5s and 10s. We have used repeated addition, concrete resources and visual resources to support us as we count.





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Next Week

Next week in English, we will be using our amazing storyboard to start to write our adventure stories involving Mowgli.

We will be starting our History unit where we will be learning all about the Portuguese explorer Vasco Da Gama who sailed to India. We will create a timeline of the main events from his life.

In Games, we will be continuing to develop our throwing and catching skills and finding different ways to throw a ball into the air! We will then be working in teams to invent a new game, which involves throwing balls in different ways!

In Maths, we will be looking at patterns and creating two and three object patterns and describing the rule of each pattern.
