What have we been learning?

We have had a lovely week in Jet Class. In English, our focus has been on writing different poetry. Our poetry has all had a spring focus as we were set the challenge from Brunel to write him a poem to celebrate his springtime birthday in April.

In Maths, we finished our multiplication unit by multiplying using a number line. We then moved onto our new unit, which we will be covering until the end of the term on statistics. This week we have learned how to carefully, collect our data using tally marks. We have put this data into both a block chart, and a pictogram to show Brunel what we think would have been the best biscuit to offer the passengers on the SS Great Britain rather than the ship biscuits!

In Science we have continued with our material learning, this week we were set the challenge to see how objects/materials can change shape by bending, twisting, stretching and squashing. We all enjoyed this and recorded our results into a table. Ask your children what we have found out!
