What have we been learning?

This week Jet class have been authors retelling the story 'Toys in space' in our English lessons. The children have tried so hard to remember all the main events of the story, to use story language to form a narrative and to include all the grammar skills they have been taught this term. We can't wait for you to read them!

In maths, we have developed our understanding of numbers to 100; we have been partitioning two digit numbers into tens and ones using mathematical resources including dienes, numicon and multilink. We have been finding 1 more/1 less than a given number to 100 and comparing numbers using the $<$ $>$ $=$ signs. In Boolean we have been recapping our numbers bonds to 10. Find out how amazing we are at recalling these numbers bonds by asking your child to recall them at home.

In geography, we have been using globes and maps to locate Europe and the UK and find out more about where we live in the World.





In DT, we used our puppet templates to cut out the felt we needed and some children have used a running stitch to sew their puppets together. Thank you to Neeva's mummy for helping us.

In maths we will be consolidating our counting in tens, fives and twos skills.
