

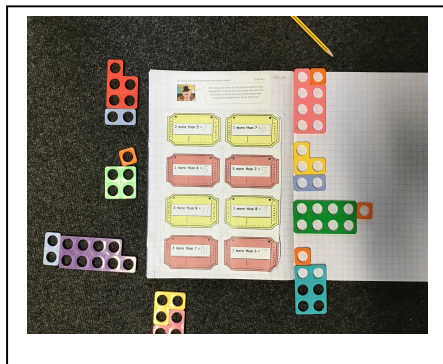


## Jet Class Newsletter

### What have we been learning?

We can't believe we are already in October, what a fantastic first month the children have had in Jet class. This week we have been busy constructing and writing compound sentences about 'The Singing Mermaid' using the conjunction 'and'. In maths we have developed our addition skills, adding one, two or three more to a given number and using this knowledge to solve 'prove it' challenges.



In DT we started to create our backgrounds for our moveable sea pictures using a variety of collage materials.

In dance we completed our 'conkers' dance. We made spikey shapes with our bodies on our own and with a partner. We moved rhythmically around the hall turning and jumping at different levels and made our bodies into exploding conker shapes.





### Next Week

In English we will be writing simple compound sentences imagining we are deep sea divers. We will use our senses to describe what we can hear, see, touch and smell.

Our maths lessons will focus on addition of two one digit number, we will use a variety of mathematical resources to support our learning including tens frames, number lines, numicon, multi-link and objects in hoops.

We are looking at the features of ocean mammals in science and comparing them to other sea creatures.

On Friday will be heading to the church for our Harvest assembly. We will be singing two songs for the other classes to enjoy.
