What have we been learning?

Another fun week in Jet Class. We have been busy writing fact sheets all about the sea creatures we researched as part of our home learning. We included sub headings, facts and questions.

We were extremely lucky to have a very informative visit from the RNLI, John told us all about the important work the RNLI do in saving lives at sea. He talked about water safety, described all the different lifeboats they use and we got to dress up and role play lifesaving drills. We raised £35 for the RNLI from our Pirate day.

In art we have experimented with colour mixing primary colours to make secondary colours on our own colour wheels and explored warm and cold colours by matching watercolours to pictures. We have researched the famous artist Van Gogh and compared his seascape painting to other famous sea paintings talking about what we liked/disliked.
