This week in Jet class we have become authors. We have been using our storyboards from last week to start writing our adventure stories. We have applied all the grammar skills we have been taught this term including using expanded noun phrases and suffix endings to describe our story setting and jungle character.

We have started our history learning researching the famous explorer 'Vasa Da Gama' and finding out all about his life and why he is famous. We created our own timelines to plot the main events of his life.

In art we have been busy developing our sketching skills, we have been sketching jungle animals looking closely at the animal's shapes, size and features. We peer critiqued each other sketches and then used the warm feedback to improve and redraft our drawings. We also experimented with Styrofoam printing and paint to create animal skin pattern prints.









In science we have started our unit on Living things and their habitats. We carried out lots of activities investigating objects that are living, dead or have never been alive.

Next week

In English, we will be completing the last two sections of our adventure jungle stories. We will be applying our skills to write about the problem and resolution from our storyboards.

In maths we be focusing on times table facts (2, 5, and 10) and odd and even numbers.

In science, we will be developing our understanding of living things and their habitats. We will be identifying the basic needs of living things.

In Jigsaw, we will be using the 'Recovery package' to discuss how we can manage our worries and fears with the help of our jigsaw friend 'Jigsaw Jo'.
