What have we been learning?

The children had a lovely day on Wednesday participating in Sports Day. Luckily the weather got better and better as the day progressed and we were able to enjoy the day fully. In English this week we have started a new class story, 'Trust Me, Jack's Beanstalk Stinks!' The children are posed a question relating to the story and have to debate what they think the best course of action is and why. The children gave impressive, thoughtful answers and listened well to each other's point of view.



In ICT we have been learning about algorithms. In Music we have listened to songs belonging to the rap genre. We learnt a new song Hey You! And performed it with actions. In Science we are continuing to learn about plants and learnt the name and function of different parts of a plants.
