This week in English we have been busy planning our persuasive letters to Farmer Brown. We need to convince him to give the animals the things they need to make them happier on the farm. We have been thinking about the animals problems and how they can be resolved. We have been applying our grammar skills thinking of adjectives ending in 'y' that we can use in our letters, along with the co-ordinating conjunctions 'and', 'but' and 'or'. Our plans are looking great with lots of detail ready to help us write our letters next week.

In Maths we have been applying our knowledge from Year 1 to answer mathematical questions in a quiz, we are really proud of how well the children challenged themselves.

In Art we have started to apply our drawing skills to create our final landscape artwork in the style of David Hockney. We thought carefully about perspective by adding objects in the foreground, middle ground and background.
