In maths we have progressed on to using the column addition method to add 2 digit and ones, two digit and tens and 2 digits and 2 digits. We have used the make it, draw it, and write it strategy to help us solve calculations and challenges. We have been trying really hard to improve our mental maths skills by completing the daily 10. You can support your child at home to practise the daily 10 by following the link below. Click onto level 1 then addition. You can choose any of the tests in this section. The children have 20 seconds to answer each question in class. They really enjoy it and are becoming very competitive.
