What have we been learning?


You will have seen on Google Classroom that through our assemblies this week we have been covering Black History Month. We have had some wonderful mature conversations and have learnt about black history, heritage, culture and achievements of significant people from the past. We have found out about Rosa Parks, Harriet Tugman and listened to the music of Florence Price.

In Maths, we have been consolidating our knowledge of number bonds to 10 and challenging ourselves with our number bonds to 20. We used different objects as representations and solved problems involving our number bonds.










In Science, we carried on with our learning: all about animals. We were set a challenge from a jungle tree frog - to find out all about her life cycle. We first made a whole class cycle after being given parts out of order and worked together as a team to sequence.

We then used our knowledge of the life cycle to create a picture fact sheet, showing the sequence and the scientific names of the frog at each stage.









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Next Term

We will be moving onto our Geography focus where we will compare Wickwar with India. We will be using the book, Lily's Garden, to help us with this.

In Jigsaw, we will be celebrating differences.

In Science, we will be continuing with our learning, which started this term, around humans and animals and will be moving on to look at simple food chains.

In Dance, we will be learning traditional English folk dancing and comparing with traditional Indian dancing.

In Games, we will be developing our skills for kicking, aiming and hitting with balls.

During our computing sessions, we will be learning how to make a PowerPoint.

Alongside this, we will also be covering many exciting areas in Maths and English.
