



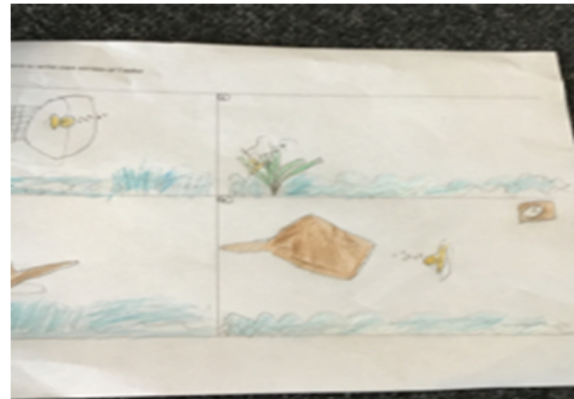
# Jet Class Newsletter
