## What have we been learning?

We loved our Wow craft day creating jungle animal masks, collage parrots and snake paper chains using a variety of different media. We enjoyed watching the film 'The Jungle Book' after reading the story in class.



In English we have been retelling our favourite parts of the The Jungle Book story, trying to remember to apply all the skills we learnt last year and improve our stamina for writing. In maths we developed our partitioning skills, we looked at different ways we would make two digit numbers and then used a variety of resources to represent the two digit number using tens and one. To challenge ourselves we found all the different ways to partition a two digit number, it was tricky but once we saw the pattern we cracked it!!

We started our first art project looking at jungle animal prints and patterns, discussing which ones we liked/disliked and explaining why? We looked at different techniques for printing and created our own texture rubbings to represent different animal skin.
