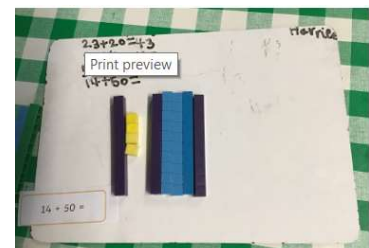
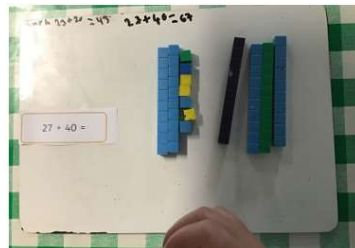
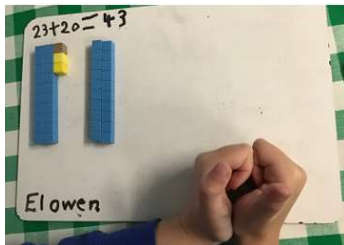
### What Have We Been Learning?

We started our week in school with a wonderful Harvest Service on Monday with Pastor David Frampton from Charfield. Jet Class performed a rousing rendition of a Farmer's Life for Me to the rest of the school. Thank you for all your kind food donations, these will be making their way to a worthy cause shortly.

In English this week we have started writing letters to Farmer Brown to persuade him to give the animals the things they are asking for. The animals are threatening to go on strike and the children were worried Farmer Brown might have to shut his farm if he doesn't give in to the animals' requests!! They have been very engaged and excited (some may ask where exactly Farmer Brown's farm is in Wickwar!!) and have been showing us their great writing skills by applying noun phrases and coordinating conjunctions in their writing.



In Maths we are starting to think about adding multiples of 10 to a 2 digit number. This week we have focused on using manipulatives to help the children work out some tricky number sentences. We will progress to using a written method, on number lines, as we become more confident.
