Amelie D- I loved the Bollywood dancing workshop. It was really good to get to learn all of the different moves.

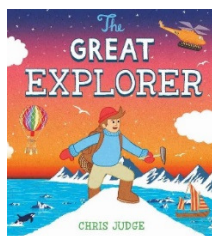
Rory- My favourite learning, was making the jungle collages, because you could use your imagination and use any colours or animals you wanted as long as it was in the style of Henri Rousseau.
