



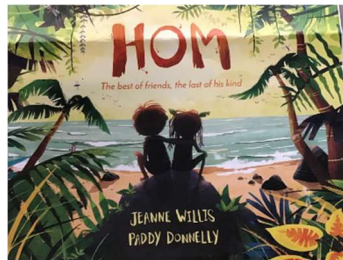
Jet Class Newsletter
