What have we been learning?

We have had a really lovely week in Jet Class. The hightlight was our scooter training on Wednesday! The session started with a virtual teaching session about how to be safe and use our scooter. Then we went out in small groups to put our new skills into action. The children all listened very carefully to the instructions and performed the challenges well.





In Science this week, we have been learning all about the basic needs of animals including humans. We played a great game where we thought like a scientist and decided if the picture cards were showing a need the animal had to have in order to survive or just a want that would be nice to have. This led to some very interesting and mature conversations between the children.



Through Maths, we have been exploring odd and even numbers. We were looking at patterns again to be able to recognise within a 2 digit number if it is odd or even. We now know that to decide if a 2 or 3 digit number is odd or even, we need to look at the last digit to help us decide. Ask your child what numbers would need to be on the end for it to be odd? What would it need to be for it to be even?
