What have we been learning?

We started this week doing 'word of the week', this is something which we will do weekly in Jet Class, each week we will introduce a new word, ask the children if they know the meaning of the word and if they can put the word into a sentence. The children are also encouraged to use the word in their writing during the week. This is a good opportunity for them to be introduced to a wider range of vocabulary.





As scientists, we started looking at different animal groups. We wanted to see what we already knew, so we listened to a song to introduce us to the different animal groups-mammals, amphibians, reptiles, fish and birds. We then had many different pictures of sea animals and we had to decide which animal group they would belong in due to the features that they have. Over the next few weeks, we will be looking at each animal group in more detail.



This week, we took our Maths outside. We created a number line in three parts to show the line, on the top line we have the numeral (digit), on the middle line we had the number name in words, and on the bottom line, we had the representation of that amount using numicon. The children were excellent at matching the three parts together.

In RE, we listened to the bible story- Noah's Ark. The children all listened very carefully. They were then given different picture cards from the story and together in groups, they had to put them into the correct sequence.







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Next Week

In RE, we will be continuing to look at the bible story of Noah's Ark and we will be thinking of questions we would ask both God and Noah about the event.

In Science, we will be looking in more detail at one of the animal groups we have focused on this week. We will be looking at all the features, which would classify an animal as a fish.

In English, we will be having a grammar focus looking more closely at the conjunction 'and', and how we can use it to expand our sentences.

In Maths, we will be building on the skills we learnt this week by comparing three or more numbers to find the greatest or the least. We will then be moving on to find one more or less than a given number.
