What have we been learning?

The children have been busy using their research from home on jungle animals to write a detailed fact file, they have been organising their ideas into sections, using sub headings and applying their understanding of noun phrases.

In maths we have been consolidating our understanding of $<$ $>$ $=$ signs to compare numbers and are beginning to develop our mental maths, counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.

We have been using our Creativity ELLI power in art to create our own jungle leaf tile. We have been mixing green, black and white to create different tints and tones for our tile.

In Art they will be continuing to create their jungle collages in the style of Henri Rousseau.
