What have we been learning?

We have moved onto our new class story 'Tiddler' this week. We have used the pictures in the story to imagine that we are divers exploring under the sea. We used our 5 senses to describe what we could hear, see, hear, smell and taste. We used our knowledge of adjectives to describe the nouns and extended our sentences with 'and'.

In maths we have been using tens frames, numicon and part whole models to find number bonds. In Daily 10, we have been developing our mental maths recalling number bonds to 10.

We are really enjoying developing our collage skills in art, we have practised creating our collage mermaid/mermen tails in our sketchbooks and are ready to create our final tails.
