
## What have we been learning?

We have been working hard on making our Indian Fact PowerPoints. We have learnt how to add slides and choose the design we wanted to have. So far, we have added our titles and sub-headings. This week, we have worked on our word processing skills to add the facts.



We have found out all about the Indian festival of Holi. We all thought this looked like a great celebration to be involved in, especially with the throwing of colourful paint powder! After looking at lots of photographs and watching videos we became journalists for the day, and wrote a newspaper report in the past tense as if we had been there!

In Maths, we have continued to develop our subtraction skills. This week, we have been focusing on subtracting tens from a two-digit number, as well as subtracting a two digit number and a two digit number. The children used both their 100 square and both a numbered and unmarked number line to find the answers.





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## Next Term

It is our last week in computing, where we will be learning to add pictures into our PowerPoints. We will then be adding them onto Google Classroom for you to share with your child at home.

In RE, we will be moving on to look at the Christian celebration of Christmas and learning about this sacred story.

In Maths, we will be looking at commutativity, where the children will learn that addition can be done in any order, but subtraction must always have the largest number first. We will also be looking at fact families for addition and subtraction facts.

In English we are working on our oracy skills, where we will be using our talking skills to give for and against arguments about whether Lily should have gone into the garden of India without her mother's permission. We will be developing our listening to each other viewpoints and seeing if that makes us change our mind.

During our games session, we will be putting into practise all of the new skills we have learnt this term linked to dribbling. Through the games, the children will need to show that they can dribble, change direction and stop in a controlled way.

## Other News

We will be completing the phonics screening assessment across the whole of Year Two, this will take place throughout the whole week. We will keep it very low key and all of the children have had lots of practice at the quizzes so we know that they will all be fine.
