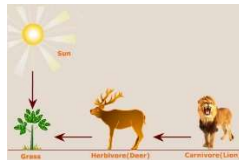

Home learning

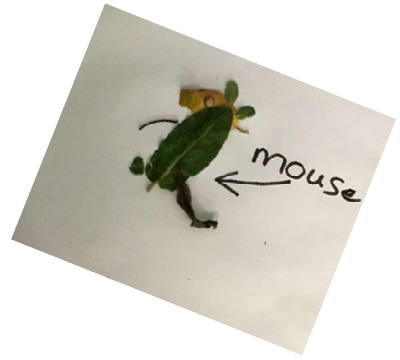
This week's home learning can be found on google classroom. We have set a two week research project on India and a phonic screening practice. You will not need to submit the phonics screening learning to Google classroom.
