What have we been learning?

The children have been very excited this week sharing with each other their experiences of opening advent calendars and elf antics! In class we became diary writers using our imagination to step back in time and become Grace Darling. We applied our knowledge of past tense writing using verbs ending in -ed and included lots of feelings in our diaries.

In Grammar we have been learning to spell adjectives adding the suffix endings -er and -est to describe settings in our class text 'The Snail and the whale'.

In art we started to create the background to our seascape paintings using watercolours and large brushes to create different tones of blue to represent the sky and sea. We then added acrylic paint, salt and sand to add texture to create the waves in the sea using cotton buds, small brushes and glue spreaders

In English we are writing postcards in the role of the snail from 'The snail and the whale' story. We will be applying our skills spelling adjectives using -er and -est.

Our maths learning will be focusing on subtracting one digit from a one-digit number and one digit from a two-digit number for numbers up to 20. We will be using number tracks, number lines, bar models and mathematical resources.

In art, we will be adding our carefully drawn sailing boats to our seascape paintings to complete our mini outcome.
