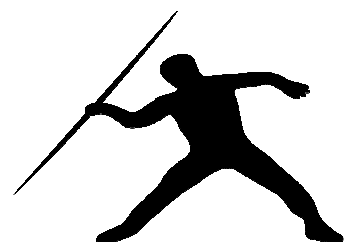
The children followed maps, to help them to explore the school grounds and find the points located on the map. A great time was had by all.
