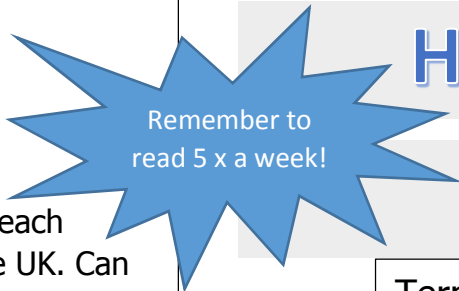




Maths
