E.g. Julius has VI times more slaves than Marcus who has XIV slaves. How many slaves does Julius have?

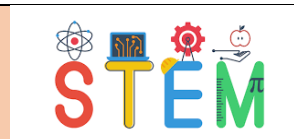
Answer: LXXXIV
