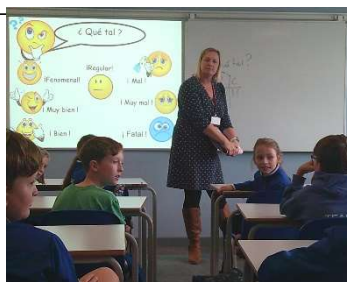


Pearl Class Newsletter
