#### The Outdoor Centre

- Separate area of the Kilve Court site only occupied by our children throughout the stay.
- Large communal hall where children eat and complete activities in bad weather.
- Cabins where small groups of children sleep.



### Cabins

- 3 or 4 children per cabin. (Children will make a list of who they would like to share with and we will place them in cabins with these choices in mind.)
- Cabins are heated.
- Storage space.
- Bunk beds 5 beds per cabin
- No toilet or water facilities there is a separate block for toilets and showers.



#### Activities

- Itinerary not yet confirmed but requested activities are:
- Climbing wall
- Mountain biking
- Frisbee golf
- Low ropes course
- Team building
- Beach walk
- Disco (evening)
- Maze or Trivia hunt (evening)













#### Food

- Children will not go hungry!
- Breakfast selection of cereals, toast, yoghurts, fruit and a cooked option (they can have all of these!)
- Lunch choice of sandwich or wrap, salad, crisps, fruit and sweet snack.
- Dinner children select main meal from five options each night and have a dessert.
- Drinks and snacks provided between activities throughout the day
- Cater for any allergies

## What to bring/not to bring...

- Kit list to follow due to the time of year, layers would be a good option!
- Wellies are good for the beach walk to go into the rock pools.
- Torch (useful for finding way around camp at night but there is a large floodlight in the middle of the cabins)
- No electronics (mobile phones, tablets etc.)
- Please do not pack additional snacks (they will not need them!)

#### **Implications of Covid19**

- A full risk assessment has been completed by Kilve Court and will be updated prior to our visit.
- Cleaning of surfaces and areas commonly used increased.
- Handwashing this has always been a part of our days at Kilve but will be increased.
- Equipment used by groups will disinfected and/or quarantined so only children from our 'bubble' will be using it.
- Only our class will be using the Outdoor Centre during our stay so will not be mixing with other groups.
