This week in English we have been learning about parenthesis using brackets, dashes and commas, applying our understanding to write a diary entry as either a Celt or Roman during the invasion of Britain. Next week we will be writing newspaper reports about the Roman Invasion.

In Maths, we have been looking at equivalence between fractions, decimals and percentages. Using cones and a large space in the hall we explored this practically, creating various fractions, decimals or percentages. Next week we will begin learning about Roman numerals.



We have begun looking at the properties of materials in Science by investigating thermal insulators. In groups we planned and carried out experiments with different materials to see which one kept hot water warm for the longest.

As part of our History, we have also been timelining the events during the Roman invasion.
