# Pearl Class Newsletter



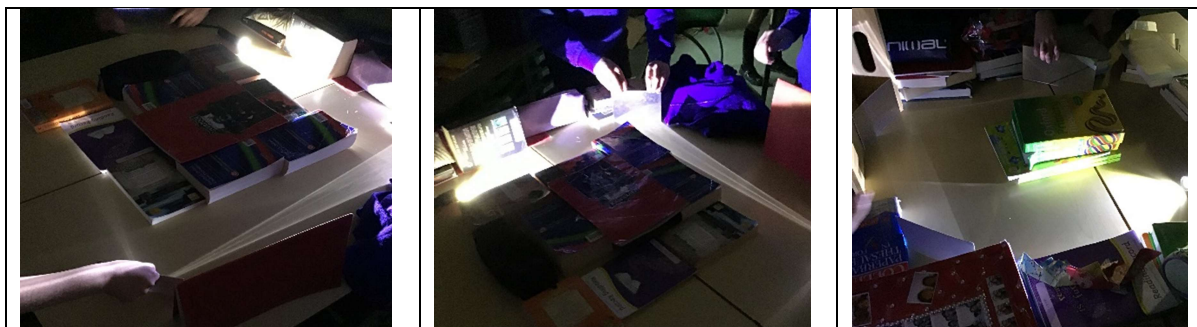
Science – Light travels in a straight line. The children enjoyed investigating with reflections in a mirror and made a mirror maze for the light beam.
