Pearl Class Newsletter

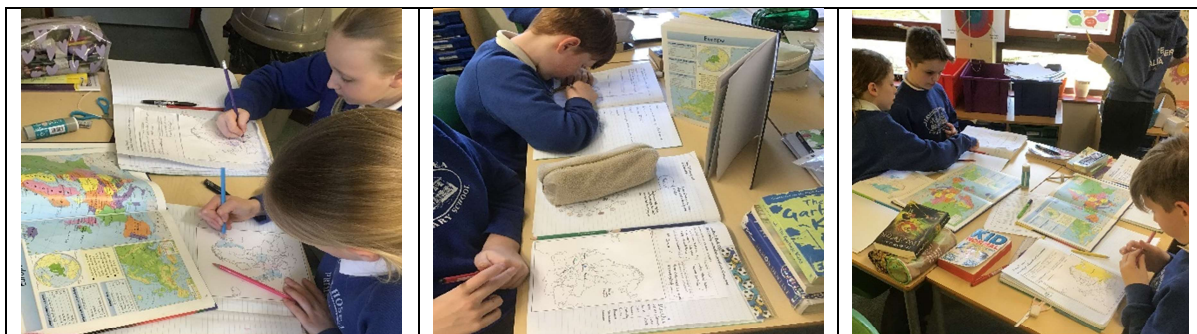


We have had a busy two weeks back to school and the children have come back ready as ever!
