
Friday 11th October 2019

In maths this week, we have been learning about factors. We started by using apparatus and visual representations to help work out if a number could be divided exactly into another. Our learning continued by making links with our timetables knowledge and we are currently investigating divisability rules. Next steps are squared and cubed numbers and multiples.









In Science, we have been planning and carrying out an investigation on gravity by trying to answer the question: Does the weight of an object affect the speed it falls? Children have been busy working collaboratively and are currently at the stage when they will present their results and make conclusions based on their outcomes.
