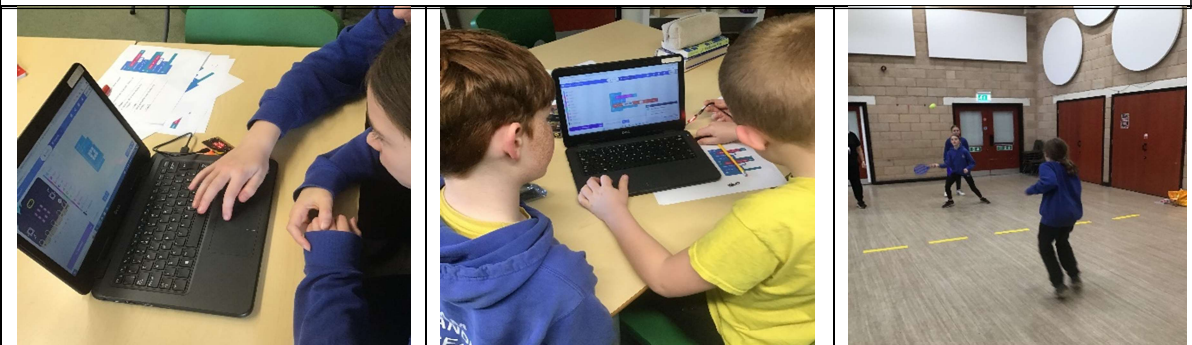
History and English-We have finished and edited our balanced argument- Were children healthier in WW2 than today?
