



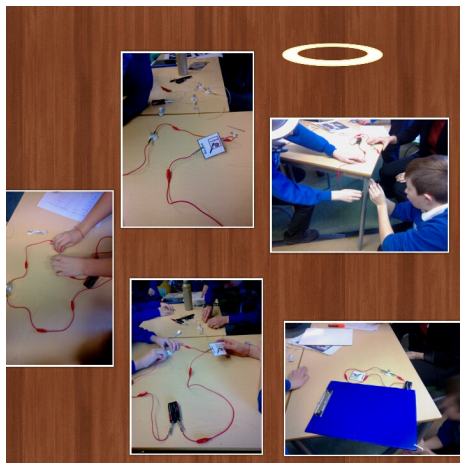
Pearl Class Newsletter

This week in English we have been writing newspaper reports about the Roman Invasion. Although we found this initially challenging as we had to imagine it was actually 43AD, through the use of excellent perseverance we have managed to write engaging reports which also apply our grammatical learning. Next week we will be beginning to think about writing our own stories set during the Roman Invasion of Britain.

In Maths, we have been learning about Roman numerals and solving challenging problems involving them. We are now able to write numbers up to and beyond 1000, with some of us even using numbers above 10,000! We will now begin learning about angles: how they are measured, how to draw them accurately and exploring angles in shapes.

Continuing our Science learning, we have been exploring materials and whether they conduct electricity.
