Pearl Class Newsletter

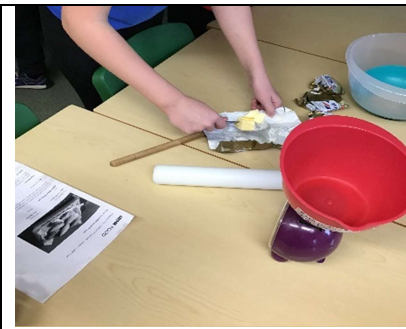


In maths this week we have been solving missing angle problems, using our knowledge of angles in a triangle, around a point, on a straight line and within a quadrilateral.
