Our learning this week:

Maths:

We have been investigating polygons and have classified them according to their properties. We have learnt that regular polygons have both length of the sides and angles of the same size. The children have also investigated irregular polygons. We have then moved onto identifying triangles – isosceles, equilateral and scalene and are in the process of classifying and naming quadrilaterals. It would be beneficial to revise and consolidate this learning at home especially describing the properties of all these shapes.

Cross-curricular learning:

We have been looking at the Water Cycle and focussing in on the explanation of the vocabulary used in this process — evaporation/water vapour, condensation and precipitation. There are some interesting YouTube clips on this subject should your child wish to find out more information.

Art:

Children have practised skills of using watercolour techniques.






Next week:
