ENGLISH:

We have been talking about figurative language and the techniques authors use to paint a picture for their reader. We have focused the main part of the learning on comparing similes and metaphors. The children had fun drawing metaphors ie it's raining cats and dogs. The final outcome was to apply this learning to write friendship poems which linked to the work we had been exploring during Anti Bullying Week..

MATHS

We have been learning how to do long multiplication . First of all we tried to multiply a two digit number with a two digit number ie 23×33 and once the children had secured the process, we made the numbers slightly more challenging and included carrying ie 27×36 . Most children have made really good progress and are feeling confident to do this independently.

CULTURE

The children started the week by taking part in a dance workshop on Diwali. They learnt about the story of Rama and Sita and the meaning behind the various dance moves . The pictures show how much they enjoyed the session.
