

We began the week by walking over 40 miles of our total 160 mile distance by completing laps of the school field.







In maths we have been working on our skills of measuring length, choosing appropriate resources (30cm rulers, metre sticks or trundle wheels) to measure a variety of objects and spaces around the classroom and in the playground. Using our knowledge of multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000, we've been converting between millimetres, centimetre, metres and kilometres. Next week, we will continue to build these skills with a focus on measuring mass and capacity.

In English we have been finishing and editing our Brightstorm stories. Over the last couple of weeks of term, we will be looking at and writing our own non-chronological reports about one of the interesting animals/creatures found in 'The Great Wide'.
