This week in Maths we have been counting forwards and backwards in 10s, 100s, 1000s, 10,000s and even 100,000. This has been challenging when having to count backwards when there is a zero in a column for example: counting back in 10,000s from 103,624. We have also begun to look at rounding large numbers and will continue this next week.

In English we have been trying to improve our understanding of complex sentences, learning about different clauses and practising with lots of sentences. Next week we will apply our skills to write the story of Curiosity in our own words.
