Maths – Converting between units of time and solving problems involving time intervals.

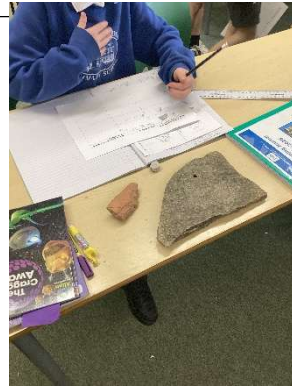
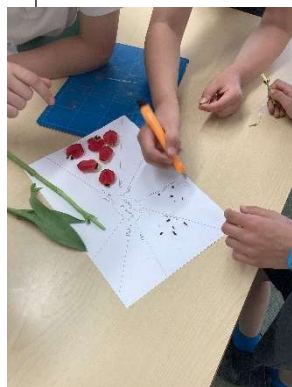
English- Writing their own narrative based on the Varmints story.
