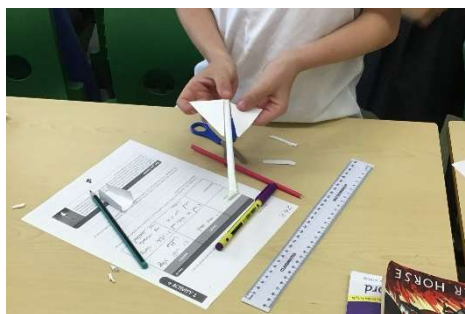


Climate Change and Energy– The children have started our learning on Climate change and focused on renewable and non-renewable energy sources.
