We have combined our English and Science this week by researching and writing about the life cycles of mammals, amphibians, reptiles, insects and birds; making comparisons between the different animal groups.

Our Maths this week has involved exploring angles through artwork. Using paintings by Kandinsky we have recapped the different types of angle, learnt how to use a protractor to measure angles and have looked at the properties of angles e.g. angles on a straight line add up to 180° , angles at a point add up to 360° and opposite angles are equal. We will putting our protractor skills to the test to create our own Kandinsky style pieces, drawing specific angles and demonstrating the different angle properties.
